



How to explore a museum in a group

Below are questions you can ask students to help them explore and notice nature collections made by scientists and community members.

1. Explore!

Choose a small area in the museum. Show students some boundaries that you are comfortable with.

- What do you see in this (exhibit, tank, video, etc.)?
- What do you find interesting?
- What do you think the scientists found interesting?

1. 探索!

在博物館裏找一個小地方, 讓學生們知道他們可以活動的範圍

- 什麼令你最感興趣?
- 你認為那些東西最令科學家感興趣?



2. Compare & Look for Patterns

- How are these things the same or different?
- What more can we find when we look closely? Are there details we haven't talked about?
- Where else can we spot _____ (scales or feathers or...)?
- What questions do you have? How might we find the answer to those questions?

2. 比較和尋找模式

- 這些東西有那些相同或不同之處?
- 小心觀察一下,你能否再發現有其 他相似或不同之處?這些細節我們 是否還沒有討論到?
- 再看看是否有其他發現(如魚鱗或羽 毛或其他細節)?
- 你有沒有其他問題?我們如何尋找 這些問題的答案呢?



3. Chat & Reflect

- What is something you hadn't seen or noticed before in this area?
- What is your favorite part?
- Think of someone who isn't here who would enjoy hearing about this?

3. 互相討論和反思

- 有什麼地方我們之前沒有留意到的?
- 那個部分你最喜歡?
- 有沒有其他人你想會對這感興趣?



4. Do it again!

When you're all done, have students take turns choosing the next collection to explore. Check out the map on the other side of this paper.
