Please note: Younger kids may need some help printing, cutting, taping, and stapling for this craft.


Materials

Ocean animals print-out (pages 2–3) 2 paper plates Scissors Crayons, markers, or colored pencils Glue Tape Thin string or thread Stapler


Directions


- 1. **Print out** the ocean animals on pages 2-3, or draw your own. Color and cut them out.
- 2. **Color** the bottom of one paper plate blue.
- 3. **Glue** the ocean animals onto the blue paper plate. Save one or two fish for the next step.
- 4. **Cut** a piece of thread to about half the length of the paper plate. Tape one end of the string to the back of a fish cut-out. Tape the other end of the string to the top edge of the paper plate. The fish will hang down into the scene as if it is swimming in the diorama.
- 5. **Cut out** a large circle from the bottom of the second paper plate. Place it upside-down on top of the first plate and staple the two plates together, around the edges.













THREADFIN BUTTERFLY FISH






COPPERBAND BUTTERFLY FISH
